Our Approach

Oswestry Dental Laboratory take our global ethical responsibilities very seriously and are committed to preventing modern day slavery and human trafficking within our business, including within our supply chains, contractors, and business partners. We acknowledge our responsibilities under the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and work to ensure transparency within our company, and with suppliers of goods and services to our company.

We expect the same high standards from all of our contractors, suppliers and other business partners, and therefore;

- We will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.
- We expect each organisation in our supply chain to ensure that forced, compulsory, or trafficked labour is not used, that no worker is held in slavery or servitude, and child labour is not used.
- We expect each organisation in our supply chain to undertake reasonable checks to ensure that their own suppliers meet the same standard.
